



Get X (formerly Twitter) API key pair






(3) Enter project name. Click on “Next” button.

(1) Enter your app name. Click on the “Next” button.



(3) If you want to change the app details information (app name, icon, description) click on the **“Edit”** button and modify the info as you want. Click on **“Save”** button to complete.

(4) On “App permissions” section, select “Read” permission and turn on “Request email from users” option. On “Type of App” section, select “Web App, Automated App or Bot” option.
